3. A ten-page writing sample (poets may submit up to ten poems).
4. A letter of recommendation from UCF faculty emailed to [EnglishScholarships@ucf.edu](mailto:EnglishScholarships@ucf.edu) by the faculty member.
5. A brief curriculum vitae to include service/work experience.
