

The Education Department at the Holocaust Memorial Resource & Education Center of Florida is currently accepting applications for its Fall 2024 collections internship program.

Internship Project:

The intern will work directly with the education staff to develop exhibition programming over the span of 15 weeks. Responsibilities include:

- Researching Holocaust topics;
- Identifying primary source materials;
- Creating exhibition copy; and
- Assisting with the installation of exhibitions.

This internship requires a minimum of 120 hours over a span of 15 weeks from August 19, 2024 to November 26, 2024. Hours can be spread or condensed throughout the work week. *All work must take place onsite between the days of Monday-Friday from 10 AM-4 PM*.

Qualifications:

- Currently enrolled in a master's program in library science, archival studies, museum studies, history, or public history.
- Ability to lift up to 25 lbs.
- Reliable transportation.
- Ability to work on-site between the hours of 10 AM-4 PM for a minimum of 120 hours per internship session.

Compensation:

A stipend of \$1,000.00 will be provided.
