UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES

Bachelor of Music in Cello Performance:

- 1. First movement of a major concerto including cadenzas where appropriate
- 2. An etude by Popper
- 3. One movement from any of the Six Cello Suites by J.S. Bach
- 4. At least one selection should be performed by memory

Bachelor of Music Education in Cello:

- 1. Two contrasting pieces demonstrating ability (may include etudes)
- 2. One movement from any of the Six Cello Suites by J.S. Bach
- 3. Applicant's choice of two varying three-octave scales and their arpeggios

Bachelor of Arts in Cello:

- 1. Two contrasting pieces demonstrating ability (may include etudes)
- 2. Applicant's choice of two varying three-octave scales and their arpeggios

GRADUATE STUDIES

Master of Arts in Music (Cello)

- 1. First movement of a major concerto including cadenzas where appropriate
- Two movements from any of the Six Cello Suites by J.S. Bach (performed by memory)
- 3. A work of the applicant's choice
