Harp Audition Requirements

Undergraduate Studies

- Two contrasting solo works or concerti that demonstrate your level of technical and musical ability. Transcriptions and individual movements from larger works are acceptable; memorization is encouraged but not required.
- 2. One standard orchestral excerpt

Graduate Studies

Memorization is required for all solo works. Applicants may choose a concerto movement for any of the solo requirements. Transcriptions and individual movements from larger works are acceptable with the exception of the sonata choice in category 2.

- 1. One solo work from the Baroque or Classical period
- One post-tonal solo work composed after 1950 OR A complete major 20th or 21st century harp sonata or suite (Hindemith, Tailleferre, Britten, Lizotte "Suite Galactique," etc.)
- 3. One solo work of applicant's choice
- 4. One standard orchestral excerpt
